Misbehavior Consequences: Grades 2 – 8

On a Quarterly Basis

Each behavior policy infraction results in a Behavior Strike for Technology Class.

Strike 1: Behavior Notice Emailed Home Via Rediker

Strike 2: Behavior Notice Emailed Home Via Rediker

Strike 3: Behavior Notice Emailed Home Via Rediker and 7:00AM Before School Detention

Assigned

Strike 4+: Behavior Notice Emailed Home Via Rediker and 7:00AM Before School Detention Assigned

- Verbal Warnings will be used at the teacher's discretion for minor infractions only.
- Students may have their seat re-located, as an immediate consequence.
- Students who accumulate 3 Behavior Strikes in 1 Quarter will be issued an After School Detention.
- Before School Detentions may be enforced for major offenses as mentioned in the school handbook, without 3 Behavior Strikes accumulating. In such a case, if it is the student's first or second offense, the student will receive Strike 1 or Strike 2 but still serve the After School Detention even though Strike 3 has not been reached at that time.
- Parent Conferences may be scheduled as needed.
- At the start of a new Quarter, each student begins with 0 Behavior Strikes.

Misbehavior Consequences: EC3 – Grade 1 On a Class by Class Basis

Verbal Warning: Issued for Minor Offenses Per Teacher's Discretion

Should Misbehavior Continue or Initial Behavior Be Deemed More Than Just a Minor Offense:

Yellow: Move Name to Yellow on Class Behavior Chart, Student Place in Timeout, and Behavior

Noticed Emailed Home Via Rediker

Red: Move Name to Red on Class Behavior Chart, Student Seat Moved, Behavior

Noticed Emailed Home Via Rediker

• A student's name may be moved to Red on the Class Behavior Chart immediately without being moved to Yellow if the action is deemed very inappropriate or very disruptive to the flow of the class.

• Parent conferences may be scheduled as needed.
